

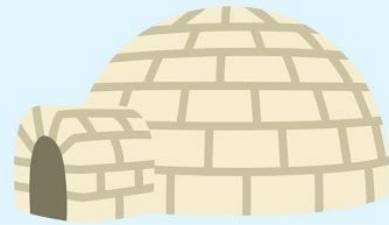


Pretend you are building a snowman. Act it out. Can someone else guess what you're doing?

Grr! You're a polar bear. Walk on all fours in the snow. Burrow into the snow. Hunt for fish in the water.

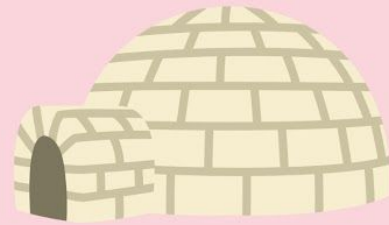


Use pipe cleaners to build a snowman. Add pompoms & felt pieces to complete your work.



Make a penguin family using playdough. Add some penguin eggs.

Use Q-tips to create snowflakes. Cut into pieces & glue to paper to create different types.



Glue cotton balls to a plastic cup to make an igloo. Cut out a door. Make a few for a village.



Paint with marshmallows! Use different sizes & dip in paint to make a winter scene.



Decorate a paper plate or paper bag to look like a polar bear.



Go on a snowball hunt! One person hides cotton balls around the room or house for you to find.



Mitten Challenge
Wear mittens indoors for 10 minutes.
Try to do normal activities.

Put on music & dance like a snowflake.
Alternate moving slowly & quickly.



Snowball Race
Use a straw to blow cotton balls across the table or floor.



Marshmallow Minute to Win It!
How many marshmallows can you stack in a minute?



Snowball Volleyball
Use a white balloon to hit back & forth for a fun indoor game.



Dance with a snowball!
Turn on music & use a white balloon as a prop.



Dance with a scarf!
Use a scarf as a prop for dancing fun.

Snowman Shadow Puppets

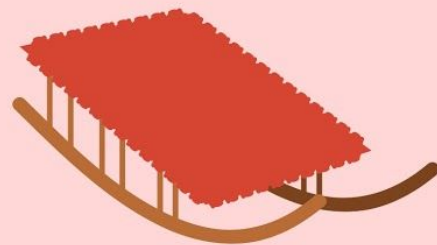
Cut out different size circles & glue to wood craft sticks. Turn off the lights & use a flashlight for indoor shadow puppet fun.



Paper Snowflakes
Use coffee filters or paper to cut out snowflakes. Make a garland or decorate windows.



Indoor Skating Fun
Put on socks & skate on a smooth floor. Practice ice skating moves.



Place pillows on floor for a make-believe sled. Pretend you are sledding down a steep & curvy mountain.
