### Summer Lego Challenges

S'mores: Materials: graham crackers chocolate squares marshmallows \*How many s'mores can you make in 1 minute-blindfolded?

### Nerf Guns:

Set up small, light objects. Designate spot to stand & shoot. Winner knocks down most objects in 1 minute.

Target: Who can can get closest to target in 1 minute?

### Popsicle Sticks:

How many popsicle sticks can you stack in 1 minute? Using popsicle sticks, how many shapes can you make?

#### Sponges:

Cut sponges into strips (4 per sponge). \*Use sponges to build tower in 1 minute. Soak in water if outside.

# Squirt Guns:

Outside, set up small objects. Designate spot to stand & shoot. Winner knocks down most objects in 1 minute.

Target: Who can can get closest to target in 1 minute?

### Ice Cubes:

Outside, how many ice cubes can you stack on top of each other in 1 minute? Mark off an area in grass. How many ice cubes can you toss into it in 1 minute?

### Jump Rope:

How many jumps can you do in one minute? Backwards? One leg? Singing a song?

# Water Balloons:

Designate target or draw circle with chalk on sidewalk. How many water balloons can you get to pop on target in 1 minute?

# Glow Sticks:

Designate an area. How many glow sticks can you toss into it in 1 minute? How many glow stick can you stack into a tower in 1 minute? More Details About ROCK YOUR HOMESCHOOL SUMMER Arts & Crafts:

Paper Plates: use paper plates to make animals, aquarium scenes, paper pizza, & more!

Paint Nature: use paint to decorate rocks, sticks, pinecones, & shells

**DIY Puzzles:** decorate foam sheets or thin cardboard. (optional: take picture to refer to while building puzzle) Adults-cut into random shapes..

DIY Stickers: Fun, Fast, & Frugal DIY Stickers Your Kids Will Love

**Aluminum Foil Fun:** glue on to paintings or pictures for embellishments. Glue onto foam sheets or cardboard and use pencil or pen point to create interesting art.

**TP Roll Crafts:** I have examples of several of these in my Storytime posts.

**Nature Box:** Decorate a shoebox as you like. Use it to store special nature objects found this summer. Optional: tape index card to inside top of box to record dates, times, object details.

**Summer Treasures Box:** Decorate a shoebox or larger. Use to store special items collected this summer. Optional: tape index card to outside of box to record dates, times, and details.

**Summer Vision Board:** create a vision board for goals & dreams for this summer. Find an example of a vision board here: <u>How To Use A Homeschool Vision Board For Inspiration</u>. You can get a free vision board planner in this link.

#### Toothpicks (or Q-tips for younger kids):

- Design a bridge from one overturned plastic cup to another using toothpicks (Q-tips). How many small objects can it hold?
- Use toothpicks (Q-tips) to create different shapes, letters, & numbers. Design your name, favorite number, or make a picture.
- Create a toothpick (or Q-tip) coaster with a bit of glue and imagination.

#### Marshmallows:

- How many marshmallows can you stack before they topple?
- Use marshmallows to create shapes, letters, & numbers.
- Paint with marshmallows!
- How long can you balance a marshmallow on your nose? Chin? Forehead?
- Place 1 marshmallow between each finger. Try to do everyday tasks like that!

#### Ring Toss:

- Cut center out of paper plates or attach glow sticks to form circle.
- Build block tower or prop up an empty paper towel roll.
- How many rings can you get around tower?

**DIY Bowling:** set up at least 6 empty & clean water or soda bottles. Use ball or aluminum foil ball to knock down.

#### More Details About ROCK YOUR HOMESCHOOL SUMMER Outdoor Fun

**DIY Lawn Dice:** decorate empty square tissue boxes (covered in construction paper) or floral foam to look like dice. Use for outdoor games like hopscotch.

**Scavenger Hunt:** create a list of common (& not so common) objects found in your area & have fun looking!

**Crayon Bars:** on a hot day, find an old muffin pan. Cut wax paper to fit each muffin slot and place in tin. Take the wrapper off old crayons and place in tin. Sit in sun and allow to melt. When cool, remove & color with your new crayon bar!

**DIY Bubble Wands:** use common household and outdoor objects to create your own bubble wands. Use objects like pipe cleaners, paper clips, yarn, grass, & your own ideas to see what works best for blowing bubbles.

**Sidewalk Art Challenges:** on index cards, write down at least 10 different art challenges to randomly select for sidewalk chalk fun.
