



Valentine's Day Poetry Fun



When you think of poetry, rhyming is probably one of the first things that comes to mind.

In this Valentine's Day Poetry Fun activity, you'll learn about rhyming in poetry & making your own Rhyming Valentine.

What is a RHYME?

A rhyme is two or more words with the same ending sound.

Example: cat, bat, that, chat, fat, hat, mat, pat, rat, sat

What are RHYME SCHEMES?

A rhyme scheme is a pattern of rhymes.

Capital letters represent the ending sounds for a specific line.

For example, A would be the ending sound in line 1. B would be a different ending sound in another line.

A few common rhyme schemes are AA, AABB, & ABAB.
